FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

To obtain your student visa from the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) you will need to provide documentation for the funding of your education. The amount of support documented must cover tuition, housing and expenses for the length of a one year visa (USD\$10,000). If you have a financial sponsor, proof of USD\$5,500 is required in the applicant's personal account, while the remaining USD\$4,500 can come from the sponsor.

1. A Bank Statement (Must be current within 3 months of semester start date, showing recent transactions i.e. debits, withdrawals, etc...)
2. An Affidavit of Support Form (can be downloaded from website; this form is to be completed by the financial sponsor and the sponsor's bank. Totals on bank statement must match totals on Affidavit of Support.) *Please contact the Admissions' Office for any questions.

TOEFL ENGLISH-LANGUAGE TEST

International students are required to take and pass the TOEFL test with an Internet Based Test (iBT) score of 61 or higher. This test is required for any student whose primary language is not English.

(www.ece.org). This includes transcripts from English-speaking countries. It is the student's responsibility to obtain the evaluation and have it sent to CCBC.
