

## Diploma in Biblical Studies (D.B.S.)

Minimum of 72 credits // Cumulative GPA of 2.0

**Minimum of 25% (18 credits) directly through CCBC** (balance may be transferred from other institutions, up to 50% from a CCBC Affiliate).
