# Dorm Life

*Guests are not allowed to stay in the dorms overnight. Students are able to contact the Student Life Coordinators if they desire to have a guest on campus. Food must be stored in the designated food storage bins or in personal mini-fridges.*

## Multimedia

- TV's, projectors, and video game consoles are not permitted in the dorms
- If a movie above a PG rating is to be shown publicly, permission must be obtained from the Student Life Coordinators (no computer or video games T rating or above are permitted.)
- Listen to appropriate music and be willing to turn it off if it stumbles others

## Internet

Any viewing of inappropriate content could result in disciplinary action. Do not visit websites that are blocked, or try to bypass the networks via "proxy" servers

## Dress Code

"Let each of you look not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others." (Phil.2:4)

### NO:

- Clothing which reveals your undergarments or provocatively reveals your anatomy (examples: leggings must be worn with long shirt, please refrain from wearing crop tops, etc.)
- Pajamas outside dorm rooms
- Walking around campus barefoot (for insurance purposes)

## Pool Dress Code & Guidelines

- Ladies with a two-piece must wear a non-transparent shirt over their suit
- No speedos
- Clothing or towel must be worn over your bathing suit when coming to or leaving the pool area

## **Housing**

- Do not climb through the windows
- Balconies and patio areas must be kept clean and orderly
- When hanging items in the dorms, please only use sticky tack or removable hooks
- No candles or open flames
- No cooking appliances in the rooms (except coffee makers & hot water kettles)
- No climbing on rooftops or balconies
- No rearranging, shifting, or relocating any furniture, including bunks, dressers, couches, etc.



# Dorm Life

## QUIET TIME

10:00pm-7:00am Is quiet time every day.

## CURFEW

- Resident, on-campus students should not stay off-campus Sunday through Thursday nights. Exceptions can be given by clearing It with your Student Life Coordinator.
- Curfew is **11:45pm**. Students must be In their respective dorms by 11:45pm with lights out by 12:00am, Sunday through Thursday. Friday and Saturday curfew Is 12:45am with lights out by 1:00am.
- Curfew violators must report to their Student Life Coordinator with an explanation for the violation. Unexcused curfew violations and failure to report to the office will result In elevated discipline.

## DORM CLEANING CHECKS

- Dorm Checks will be on **Mondays at 4pm**
- Failing dorm cleaning will result In additional cleaning responsibilities. Repetitive failures will lead to elevated discipline.
- On days your dorm room Is not checked, personal spaces are expected to be kept clean and orderly.
- Students who fail dorm cleaning will report to the Bible College Office on Tuesday at **1:00pm**.



# STUDENT LIFE

## Relationships and Morality

All relationships should honor Jesus and demonstrate purity.

"Do not rebuke an older man, but exhort him as a father, younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, younger women as sisters, with all purity." (1 Tim. 5:1-2)

- **No long embraces, kissing, or other forms of intimate contact**
- Men and women must utilize their respective dorms and are not permitted in the immediate areas (balconies, walkways, etc.) of the opposite gender's dorm.

***Violation of the following may result in dismissal from CCBC:***

## Behavior

- The use of alcohol, marijuana, tobacco products, vaping, or any illegal drugs is not permitted on or off campus
- Sexual misconduct
- Inappropriate or crude gestures or actions

## Rebellion

- Rebellion to established authority, whether CCBC/MHSCCC staff, or local and statewide government

## Stealing

- Stealing, which in some cases includes "borrowing without permission" is not allowed (Eph. 4:28)

## Dishonesty

- Cheating on tests, plagiarizing on papers, signing someone else into class, or other forms of lying and deceit (1 Cor. 6:8)

## Violence

- Physical or verbal, including threats, vulgar language and aggressive disputes (Rom. 1:29-30)
- NO WEAPONS are allowed on campus: guns, swords, knives (over 3.25"), etc.

## Discipline

- Failure to show up for a discipline related appointment may result in elevated discipline (see student catalog for more information)



# General Health Guidelines

Intentionally disregarding the guidelines set in place puts other students, staff members, campus community, and even the community outside of campus in danger, and may result in both disciplinary action and dismissal. Please ask an Intern or Student Life Coordinator for California's updated guidelines for colleges and on-campus living.

## Daily Guidelines

- Wash hands (with proper hand-washing directives, posted throughout campus)
- DO NOT go around others if you are experiencing symptoms of any kind

## If you are feeling ill:

- 1) Contact an Intern or Student Life Coordinator
- 2) Refrain from coming into contact with others as much as possible and await further instruction from Student Life Department.



# Meals & Food Storage

## Cafeteria Info & Guidelines

Minimize the spread of germs by washing hands prior to eating a meal.

### Meal Times

**Breakfast**      7:00am-8:30am (8:00-9:00am on weekends)

**Lunch**          11:30am-1:00pm (Every Day)

**Dinner**         4:30pm-6pm (Every Day)

### Dorm Room Food Storage

Dry food is able to be stored in a sealed container, and must be kept in this container when not in use. Refrigerated items are able to be stored in the dorm in a personal mini-fridge, granted the student is able to bring or purchase one upon arrival. Students with diabetic or other health-related needs for refrigerators are encouraged to contact their Student Life Coordinator for more information.





# Security

## Campus Safety

- Maintain situational awareness
- Notify a staff member of any suspicious activity

## Lock Up / Closing

- Buildings will be locked up at their respective closing times
- Public buildings will be locked by 12AM

## Transportation

- Motor vehicles and bicycles are the only modes of transportation allowed on campus (no skateboards, scooters, Heelys, etc.)

## Permits

- Parking permits are required and may be obtained at the Bible College Office. Valid registration, driver's license, and proof of Insurance are required.
- When driving in snow, chains are required.
- Bike permits are required and can be obtained at the Bible College Office

## FOR EMERGENCIES CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY

- After calling 911, contact a staff member to alert them of the situation.
- An Alert System Is In place to Inform you immediately of an emergency

## Speed Limit

- The campus speed limit is 10 MPH. Please be cautious of others walking about as you drive through campus.

# LACS Guidelines

CCBC shares the Twin Peaks Campus property with Lake Arrowhead Christian School. We ask CCBC students to refrain from entering LACS marked areas and to be mindful of daily school functions.

## **Parking**

- Please refrain from parking in front of the LACS Administration building (located behind CCBC Offices and Dorms. See parking map for more information.

## **Minors**

- Please refrain from interacting with LACS students (minors) unless you have been given clearance with both LACS and CCBC protocol.
