

# Calvary Chapel Bible College Degree Up-Grade/Re-Issue

DEGREE UP-GRADE You may up-grade your degree if you earned a Diploma of Biblical Studies (D.B.S.) or an Associate of Biblical Studies (A.B.S.) from Calvary Chapel Bible College and have since completed the additional General Studies requirements from an accredited college (see Graduation Requirements on pg. 2). Once your up-grade request has been reviewed, you will be notified via email. To be eligible for a degree up-grade in the current semester, all items must be sent by the 8th week of that semester. Otherwise the degree and diploma will be issued at the end of the following semester. There is a non-refundable \$100 fee.

Important: Students who graduated with an Associate of Theology (A.Th.) may up-grade to the Bachelor of Biblical Studies (B.B.S.).

Additional CCBC classes may be required (see pg. 2). If additional CCBC classes are required, DO NOT COMPLETE THIS FORM.

Please complete a Graduation Packet when you register for your final CCBC class(es). Distance Learning enrollments: Oct. – Feb. start dates graduate in spring; Mar. – Sept. start dates graduate in fall.

## Graduation Worksheet

The Diploma in Biblical Studies is a two-year, 72-credit, college-level program that trains students to know God and equips them to serve Him. The Associate of Biblical Studies and Bachelor of Biblical Studies degrees require specific General Studies courses to be earned through CCBC or transferred from a separate, accredited college (minimum of 18 cr. for Associate's, 36 cr. for Bachelor's. Courses that are below college level (such as remedial community college courses) are not acceptable for transfer.

Proof of high school completion is required for admission. \*The Certificate of Completion follows the same 2-year course of study as the Diploma and is intended for students who have not completed high school or have learning difficulties. See Registrar's Office for details.

### Further Information on General Studies Courses for the A.B.S & B.B.S.

General Studies courses are required for all associate and bachelor degrees. These courses may be transferred to CCBC from a separate, DOE recognized, accredited institution. Transferable general studies courses must be: 1) college-level (typically listed as 100-level), not remedial or preparatory, 2) "general" in nature, not specifically vocational or technical, 3) passed with a grade of C— or better.
