

## Calvary Chapel Bible College Graduation Worksheet

The Diploma in Biblical Studies is a two-year, 72-credit, college-level program that trains students to know God and equips them to serve Him. The Associate of Biblical Studies and Bachelor of Biblical Studies degrees require specific General Studies courses to be earned through CCBC or transferred from a separate, accredited college (minimum of 18 cr. for Associate's, 36 cr. for Bachelor's). Technical, non-academic, and vocational courses are not acceptable for transfer, nor are courses that are below college level (such as remedial community college courses). Proof of high school completion is required for admission. \*The Certificate of Completion follows the same 2-year course of study as the Diploma and is intended for students who have not completed high school or have learning difficulties. ## Further Information on General Studies Courses for CCBC Bachelor of Biblical Studies (B.B.S.):

In North American higher education, General Studies courses are required for all Bachelor's degrees. CCBC does offer courses in each of these categories, students may also transfer these courses to CCBC from a separate, DOE recognized, accredited institution. Transferable courses must be: 1) college-level (typically listed as 100-level), not remedial or preparatory, 2) "general" in nature, not specifically vocational or technical, 3) passed with a grade of C— or better.
