# Housing & Meals

## Housing:

Instead of traditional dorms, you'll live in a **gender-specific house** within walking distance to campus, with shared bedrooms, bathrooms, kitchens, and living spaces. It's a space where discipleship happens organically, through meals, conversations, and shared life.

Each home is led by a **Dorm Steward** — a fellow student who's there to support your spiritual growth, help foster a healthy rhythm of life, and point everything back to Jesus.

## Meals:

You'll **prepare your own meals** using the fully equipped kitchen in your home. We see this as more than just cooking; it's an opportunity to grow in stewardship and community.

Every student receives **\$80 per week** to cover groceries, toiletries, and essentials. This gives you the freedom to shop for what you need and plan meals together with your housemates.

We'll support you with helpful tips, encouragement, and practical support along the way. You won't be doing this alone!

**Every dorm house includes:** bunkbeds, dresser/closet, furniture, and basic kitchen appliances/dishware (blender, toaster, mixer, pots/pans, dishes/utensils, coffee maker, microwave).

# What to Bring

## **Clothing:**

Clothing for Florida weather (highs range from 90-70, expect rain in Sept.)

Bathing suit (modest suits)

Men - swim trunks or board shorts that provide appropriate coverage.

No Speedos or extremely low-cut shorts.

Women: One-piece, full-coverage tankinis are preferred. If wearing a two-piece swimsuit, please wear a non-transparent shirt over it.
